

## PIGEON POINT MEETING MINUTES OF 6/13/05

**1. NEW FLIGHT PATH** Dow Constantine is our King County Representative. Along with 2 men from the county airport, Dow explained that the county airport is considering a new flight path that would bring the planes to within 500'-1/2 mile of Pigeon Point. They will be using that path beginning this Sept. as a test. He said another plan that uses GPS would move the path midway between West Seattle and Magnolia, and be preferable for us. **2. GRAFFITI** Anthony Matlock and Daniel from Seattle Public Utilities spoke about the graffiti problem that has increased city-wide. He said we should report graffiti every time we see it at: 684-7587 and tell them what it says or take a picture of it. Then paint it out, ask your neighbor to paint it out if it's on his/her property, or leave alone and just report if it is a street sign. Anthony will deliver free paint brushes and rollers if you call him at 386-4093. He pointed out that the difference between art and graffiti is "permission".
