

OCT. 9, 2006  
**PIGEON POINT COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
7-8:30 PM with 25 neighbors attending

This meeting was structured to provide the full time for neighbors to discuss concerns/issues.

1. Steel Mill:
  - a. there is some construction going on at the mill and maybe it is to extend the shed which is needed to keep the scrap metal dry so it doesn't explode when its melted
  - b. there is a very bad smell from the mill especially on Fri. nights
  - c. call Bart Kale at Nucor to express complaints or Clean Air Puget Sound
  
2. Boeing Field flight plans:
  - a. evidently the plan Magnolia was promoting to move the flight path further over (on top of Pigeon Point) didn't materialize for several reasons including the fact that it would cause a major problem for the SeaTac flight paths
  - b. small planes can still fly over us because they don't have to follow the flight paths
  
3. Nuisance lot NE corner of Charleston and 20<sup>th</sup>:
  - a. the lot appears to be over-run with rats so it was decided that Vivian would get the owner's address and Ed would write a letter
  - b. next step will be to contact the Health Dept.
  
4. DPD inspected the boarded up red house next to the Delridge on ramp and is notifying the owner fix or the city will place a lien on it
  
5. Dogs off leash:
  - a. owners are not scooping their poop
  - b. dogs are intimidating children
  - c. PPCC will talk with Cooper's principal and look into posting "leash law" signs
  - d. We'll put a notice in the next newsletter about leashing and scooping
  
6. Cooper School:
  - a. some local families hope Cooper becomes an Environmental Focus school
  - b. Pathfinder is to move in, but how to work with the current Cooper population will need a lot of work and sensitivity
  
7. Graffiti:
  - a. if you see graffiti clean it up asap, call the city, or email the PPCC
  
8. SNAP program:
  - a. it's a framework for neighbors to organize in the event of a disaster
  - b. for our area the meeting place would be Del. Com. Center
  - c. emergency training coming up Oct. 24 at Youngstown/Cooper School and Oct. 26 at the police precinct, from 6-9

9. Skate park:
  - a. Del. Com. Center's park is a candidate for 1 of 35 when money becomes available
10. SDOT is responsible for maintenance on staircases, so call them if the shrubbery is crowding
11. Community action to increase police manpower
  - a. this Wed. and Oct. 30 are public hearings
  - b. to request 50 more police positions each year, call/write the city council members
12. Gathering of Neighbors Nov. 4, noon to 3 at Sealth
  - a. food and entertainment provided along with many booths for neighborhood resources
  - b. contact our PPCC to volunteer to sit for 1 hour at our booth
13. Train noise:
  - a. other communities (Auburn? Kent?) are limiting their train noise
  - b. call David George at 684-7843 to complain, and let Paula Bamburg know you're willing to work on the issue
14. Cars:
  - a. call SDOT on abandoned cars
  - b. some cars are driving the wrong way along the divider on 21<sup>st</sup>--- maybe we need to have "do not enter" signs posted on each end
15. Suspicious characters:
  - a. if you see someone looking suspicious or like they are camping out in one of our green belts, call 911
  - b. neighbors are suspecting that we once again have a homeless camp in the east side green belt
