PIGEON POINT COMMUNITY MEETING minutes from meeting of 4/14/09

1. Jodi Swenson suggested the community establish a day and time at the park by Concord School for play dates or visiting time, such as Saturdays at 10 am.
2. Every first Saturday of the month we are encouraged to join the Nature Consortium for clean up activities in our neighborhood. They are based in the old Cooper School on Delridge. They hosted an activity for Earthday on April 19.
3. Our PPCC Spring Clean is on Sat., April 26 this year. The dumpster will be at Andover again this year, and at 9 am neighbors are encouraged to meet at the dumpster for a work party that will cut back invasives overhanging the sidewalks.
4. Contact Matt Swenson if you know of addresses where shrubs need cutting back for easy passage on the sidewalk. He or Pete Spalding will make a list and contact SDOT asking them to address the problem with the owners.
5. We might have an article in our PPCC bulletin emphasizing the need for owners to trim shrubs back from the sidewalk.
6. Items like the "roving sofa" on 23rd can be reported to the City for removal.
7. PPCC will join Cooper School for a garage sale to benefit the school on May 10, the date for the big West Seattle Garage Sale. Items need to be delivered to the school between 6-8 pm the preceding Thurs. and Fri. Let Matt know if you can help out with the sale on the 10th.
8. If you notice strange goings-on in the neighborhood, notify Kevin McDaniel at the SW Precinct, (k.mcdaniel@seattle.gov)
9. We need a steering committee for a Welcome Newcomers event in Sept with a potluck and entertainment. We could apply for a Department of Neighborhoods grant to fund it.
10. An important reason to attend and participate in the PPCC meetings is to work towards improving our quality of life. One of these issues is the noise from the trains that impacts many of us. Contact Matt if you are interested in working on a train noise committee and he will pass your contact info on to David B. who has volunteered to lead the team.
11. Some neighbors have had foul smelling water looking rusty come out of their pipes at certain times. Call the City at 684-3000 if you have this experience.
