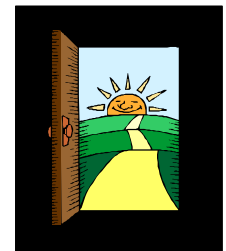
## Delridge Library Opening

The brand-new Delridge Library (at Brandon St. & Delridge Way - - next to the Neighborhood Service Center) will have the first of two opening ceremonies on Friday, April 19th from 3 - 5 p.m.

This will be the opening for the building itself, including the apartments above the library. So come and celebrate with Mayor Nickels and lots of our local community folks. Keep your eyes open for the announcement about the June opening of the library itself. This promises to be a GREAT addition to our neighborhood and a wonderful resource for students and others as well.

## The Path is In...Finally

Our new sidewalk/path on 21st Avenue south of Genesee has finally been completed and all of the walkers, runners and bikers are urged to make use of this new asset of Pigeon Point. The street edge along the path is not ideal, but we have explored all possible options with the city while they were installing the path and this was the best option for the time being, and the city will soon be hydro seeding the area. The city has ruled out a continuous curb due to drainage issues or even continuing the use of the wheel stops along the length of the path (like the ones next to the speed hump). We are continuing to work with the city to come up with a more appropriate long term solution for this situation.



In the meantime, please DO NOT park cars on the east side of 21st Ave along the path.
